It is a bitter sweet day for many.

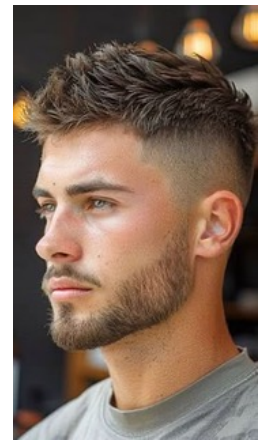
Hope you all have something very special planned for the day.
